Day 1- Thursday, Aug 23: Depart for Tel Aviv, Israel.

Day 2- Friday, Aug 24: Arrive in Ben Gurion airport. Proceed to the ancient Roman city of **Caesarea** on the Mediterranean coast. This is where the Apostle Paul was imprisoned before going to Rome and the place where the Holy Spirit fell on the house of Cornelius, a Roman Centurion. Continue to **Mount Carmel** where Elijah challenged to the false prophets. From there the road winds to Tiberius and the beautiful Sea of Galilee where we have dinner and spend the night at the Sea of Galilee.

Day 3- Saturday, Aug 25: Today we will board our boat for a cruise on the **Sea of Galilee**. We visit the 2,000-year-old "**Jesus Boat**." Then we make our way to **Magdala** and the **Mount of Beatitudes**. We will visit the very Synagogue where Jesus gave His first sermon.

Day 4- Sunday, Aug 26: Visit the ancient fishing village of **Capernaum**, home of the apostle Peter. Our tour then takes us through the beautiful Golan Heights where we will hear the explanations of the strategic and political significance of this area; then to the headwaters of the Jordan and the city of **Caesarea Philippi** where Jesus, standing amongst the Roman gods asked the disciples, "Who do men say that I am?" We travel down to the Sea of Galilee for dinner and another restful night in the Galilee area.

Day 5- Monday, Aug 27: This morning we travel down the Jordan Valley, passing the ancient city of Beit Shean and Mt. Gilboa. We arrive at the place across from Jericho where Joshua and the children of Israel crossed the Jordan into the Promised Land and also where John baptized Jesus (we will take time here for those wishing to be baptized). From there we go to the **Qumran** caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered and then on to **Masada** and **Ein Gedi** where you can swim (float) in the Dead Sea. We then make our way up the steep Judean hills to the Holy City of Jerusalem. Here we have dinner and spend our first night in the City of the Great King.

Day 6- Tuesday, Aug 28: Today our tour begins on the **Mount of Olives** overlooking the Kidron Valley (also known as the Valley of Jehoshaphat) across from the Eastern Gate. We will walk down an ancient pathway to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where we will spend time in prayer. The next stop is the house of Caiaphas not far away where Jesus was mocked by soldiers and where Peter denied Him. Just across the way we go to the **Upper Room**, then to the **Southern Steps** that Jesus walked on. Sift at an archeological dig site called **Emek Zurim**. We'll make our way to the hotel have dinner and rest.

Day 8- Wednesday, Aug 29: This morning we will ascend the Temple Mount where the Jewish Temple once stood and where Jesus taught many times. We will then walk stop at the **Pool of Bethesda** and then to the Pretorium where Jesus was judged by Pilate and beaten by the Roman Soldiers. From there we step out onto the **Via Delarosa**, the path where Jesus was led to Calvary, and make our way to the **Western Wall** where we will spend time in prayer. We will then travel through the **Rabbi's Tunnels** along the underground walls of the Temple. Afterwards, we will go to our hotel for dinner and another night of rest.

Day 9- Thursday, Aug 30: Our first stop will be the fascinating **City of David** the site of very recent archeological digs. From there we enter Zion's Gate to the Cardo, then by David's Citadel and through Jaffa Gate to board our bus for the Holocaust Memorial, Yad VaShem. Afterwards, we will go to the Israeli Museum home of the Model City and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. From there to our hotel, a nice dinner and a time to relax.

Day 10- Friday, Aug 31: After breakfast we travel to the view **Bethlehem**, the Shepherd's fields where the Angels proclaimed the birth of Jesus to the lowly shepherds tending their sheep. We then go to the Promenade to capture a spectacular view of the Old City. We will take a group photo and enjoy the panorama seen by David and the prophets of old from this very site. Our final stop will be the **Garden Tomb** for communion followed by a farewell dinner before making our way to Ben Gurion Airport and the flight home.
